Provincial Achievement Tests Summary Results Report 2016 – 2017

The charts, beginning on page two, report High Park School's student achievement on Provincial Achievement Tests (PAT). Individual subjects are provided in historical detail on the pages that follow.

Some considerations:

Grade 6 & 9 achievement at Acceptable Standards exceeded Divisional and Provincial Averages:

- Grade 6 rates of achievement were all above both divisional and provincial averages. (Anywhere from +1.2 to +5.0)
- Grade 9 rates of achievement were all above both divisional and provincial averages. (Anywhere from +8.4 to +15.3)

Grade 9 experienced growth in majority of core areas in both the Acceptable Standard and Standard of Excellence:

 Grade 9 scores rose in both Standard of Excellence and Acceptable Standard in the majority of core curricular areas.

Grade 6 Acceptable Standards scores, while high, dropped compared to last year:

• Grade 6 scores at the Acceptable Standard fell compared to previous years. While scores remain above provincial averages, this will need to be a focus for the 2017-18 school year.

Achievement in Grade 9 Language Arts and Social Studies show significant improvement:

• Last year, English Language Arts (ELA) 9 and Social Studies 9 were identified as areas of concern. Results would indicate that students achieved significant improvements in both areas with ELA rising (+10.4% in Acceptable Standard and +4.5% in Standard of Excellence) and Social Studies (+23.1% in Acceptable Standard and +4.9% in Standard of Excellence).
