Provincial Achievement Tests Summary Results Report 2015 – 2016

The charts, beginning on page two, report High Park School's student achievement on Provincial Achievement Tests. Individual subjects are provided in historical detail on the pages that follow.

Some considerations:

Grade 6 & 9 participation rates were all above the PSD and Provincial Averages

- Grade 6 rates were 95% for all four core subjects
- Grade 9 rates were 98.1% ELA, Science and Social and 96.2% for Math

Grade 9 experienced growth in Mathematics in both the acceptable standard and standard of excellence:

• Grade 9 Math rose by 1.0 at the acceptable standard and 2.4 at the standard of excellence

Grade 9 Language Arts and Social Studies identified as an area for growth

• Grade 9 Language Arts and Social Studies marks decreased from the previous year, although this achievement is in-line with historical norms

Achievement at the Standard of Excellence needs to be a focus

• While levels of excellence remain above the provincial average in most cases, there were significant drops in historical trends noted during analysis of data.
