Counselling Corner

Sleep is an important part of our mental health. The <u>Canadian Pediatric Society</u> recommends that children (6-12 years) get 9-12 hours of sleep and teenages (13-18 years) get 8-10 hours of sleep. When we are sleep deficient this can impair our ability to manage emotions & behaviors, problem solve, and cope with changes in our life. Sleep deprivation has also been linked to depression, suicide, and risk-taking behavior.
